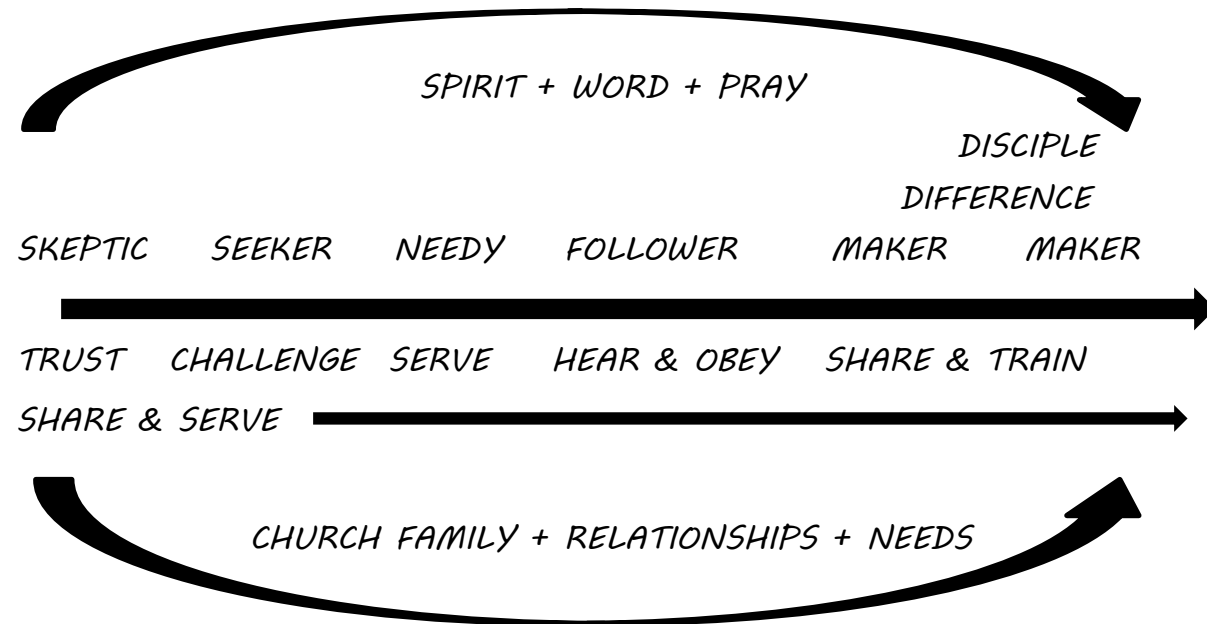

**WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?**

- I Cor 15 I want to remind you of the gospel ... <sup>2</sup> By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly.... <sup>3</sup> For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,
- Mark 1<sup>14</sup> Jesus went into Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God. <sup>15</sup> “The time has come, the kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!” Mat 9<sup>35</sup> Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, healing every disease and sickness. <sup>36</sup> When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. <sup>37</sup> Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. <sup>38</sup> Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.” 10<sup>7</sup> As you go, proclaim this message: ‘The kingdom of heaven has come near.’ <sup>8</sup> Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give.

**WHAT IS THE KINGDOM?**

- THE KING- Father & Son
  - I Tim 6:15 God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords,
  - I Cor 15<sup>24</sup> Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power.
- WHERE GOD REIGNS- heaven & earth, now & then
  - Mt 6<sup>10</sup> your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
  - Rev 11<sup>15</sup> The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever.”
- HOW GOD REIGNS - BLESSING, increasing and ruling
  - Gen 1<sup>28</sup> God BLESSED them and said to them, “Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground.” (see Gen 9, 12:1-3)
  - Rom 14<sup>17</sup> For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit,
- WHO GOD REIGNS- the humble- Mt 18<sup>3</sup> “Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. <sup>4</sup> Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
