- Dt 5²¹ "You shall <u>not covet</u> your neighbor's wife. You shall <u>not set your desire on</u> your neighbor's house or land, his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."
- Eccl 5¹⁰ Whoever <u>loves money</u> never has enough; whoever <u>loves wealth</u> is never satisfied with their income.
- Jer 6¹³ "From the least to the greatest, all are <u>greedy</u> for gain; prophets and priests alike, all practice deceit.
- Jer 22¹³ "Woe to him who builds his palace by unrighteousness, his upper rooms by injustice, making his own people work for nothing, not paying them for their labor.¹⁵ "Does it make you a king to have more and more cedar? Did not your father (King Josiah) have food and drink? He did what was right and just, so all went well with him. ¹⁶ He <u>defended the cause of the poor</u> and needy, and so all went well. <u>Is that not what it means to know me</u>?" declares the LORD.
- Ezk 16⁴⁹ "Now this was the sin of your sister Sodom: She and her daughters were <u>arrogant, overfed and unconcerned</u>; they did <u>not help the poor</u> and needy.

7 WAYS TO KILL THE GREEN-EYED MONSTER

- 1. Turn our will over to Jesus-
 - Rom 7⁷.... For I would not have known what <u>coveting</u> really was if the law had not said, "You shall not <u>covet</u>." ⁸ But sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, produced in me every kind of <u>coveting</u>.
 - Rom 8¹² Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation—but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it. ¹³ For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if <u>by the Spirit</u> you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.
- 2. Trust Jesus to meet our n____
 - Php 4 ¹² I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being <u>content</u> in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. ¹³ I can do all this through him who gives me strength. ¹⁹ And my God will <u>meet all your needs</u> according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

- 3. Thank Jesus for what we have- and give Him the ownership of it all
 - I Th 5¹⁶ <u>Rejoice</u> always, ¹⁷ <u>pray</u> continually, ¹⁸ <u>give thanks</u> in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
 - 1 Ch 29:13-14 Now, our God, we <u>give you thanks</u>, and praise your glorious name. "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? <u>Everything comes from you</u>, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.
- 4. Know the best thing we have is God's p___
 - Heb 13. ⁵Keep your lives free from <u>covetousness</u> and be <u>content</u> with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
 - Hab 3¹⁷ Though the <u>fig tree</u> does not bud and there are no <u>grapes</u> on the vines, though the <u>olive</u> crop fails and the fields produce <u>no food</u>, though there are <u>no sheep</u> in the pen and <u>no cattle</u> in the stalls, ¹⁸ yet I will <u>rejoice in the LORD</u>, I will be joyful in God my Savior.
 ¹⁹ The Sovereign <u>LORD</u> is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, he enables me to tread on the heights.
- 5. Obey the Sabbath & slow down
 - Ex 20⁸ "Remember the Sabbath day by <u>keeping it holy</u>. ⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day is a sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall <u>not</u> <u>do any work</u>, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns. ¹¹ For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he <u>rested</u> on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.
- 6. Work hard to p_____ for ourselves and others
 - Acts 20 ³³ I have <u>not coveted anyone's silver or gold or clothing</u>. ³⁴ You yourselves know that these <u>hands of mine</u> have <u>supplied my own needs and the needs of my</u> <u>companions</u>. ³⁵ In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of <u>hard work</u> we must <u>help the weak</u>, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is <u>more blessed to</u> <u>give than to receive</u>.'"
- 7. Learn to I_____ vs. being envious of others
 - Rom 13⁹ The commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall <u>not covet</u>," and whatever other command there may be, are summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁰ Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law
