❖ DIVING INTO SCRIPTURE

WONDERFUL- "beyond words & understanding, marvelous, extraordinary"
Ex 15¹¹ Who among the gods is like you, LORD? Who is like you— majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders?

Ps 177 Show me the wonders of your great love,

Ps 119¹²⁹ Your <u>statutes</u> are <u>wonderful</u>; therefore I obey them.

Judges 13 ¹⁷ Then Manoah inquired of the angel of the LORD, "What is your name, so that we may honor you when your word comes true?" ¹⁸ He replied, "Why do you ask my name? It is <u>wonderful</u>, beyond understanding."

COUNSELOR- "advise, consult, guide"

Heb 4- Jesus has the I_____and experience_

¹⁴ Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. ¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. ¹⁶ Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

2. But is Jesus available?

Mt 1 ²³ "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

3. But does Jesus want to be bothered?

Mt 11 ²⁸ "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰ For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

4. But can Jesus really <u>help</u> me? Does He have the <u>power</u>? Ps 16 ⁷ I will praise the LORD, who <u>counsels</u> me; even at night my heart instructs me. Ps 32 ⁸ I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will <u>counsel</u> you with my loving eye on you.

 Dt 30 ¹⁹ I have set before you <u>life and death</u>, <u>blessings and curses</u>. Now <u>choose life</u>, so that you and your children may live ²⁰ and that you may <u>love</u> the LORD your God, <u>listen to his voice</u>, and hold fast to him. For <u>the LORD</u> is your <u>life</u>....

 Mt 7 ²¹ "Not everyone who <u>says</u> to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, <u>but only</u> the one who <u>does</u> the will of my Father who is in heaven.

Jn 10²⁷ My sheep <u>listen to my voice</u>; I know them, and they <u>follow me</u>. ²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand.
