"The Reason for Hope!" 'Hope Has Come!' Isaiah 9:1-7

The Merriam-Webster Dictionary defines "Hope:

- 1. To cherish a desire with anticipation
- 2. To desire with expectation of obtainment or fulfillment
- 3. To expect with confidence, Trust

In the Bible, the Hebrew language has two good words for hope: (Bible Project)

- 1. Yakhal which means simply "to wait for"
- 2. **Qavah** also means "to wait", the feeling of tension and expectation, like a twisting rope; waiting on the edge of your seat for something to happen

1.) There is a hope that leaves us empty!

- A. When we place our hope in our positions, ourselves, and others, we will often be left discouraged and disappointed.
 - a. Everything on earth will perish! Matthew 6:19-21 Ecclesiastes1:1-4
 - b. The heart of man is not to be trusted! Jeremiah 17:9-10
 - c. We have all sinned and fallen short. Romans 3:23
 - d. We shouldn't let the worldly success of the world deter our hope. **Proverbs 23:17-18**

2.) Hope without expectation or fulfillment makes the heart sick! Proverbs 13:12

- A. When we hope in something that won't come to fruition we have a false sense of optimism!
- B. The Psalmist realizes that when their hope was in themselves they became discouraged and depressed within themselves. Psalm 42:11, 43:5
- C. We hand rest in God's unfailing love because of Jesus. Psalm 130:7

3.) We have Hope because Jesus has come Isaiah 9:1-7

- A. Because of Jesus we no longer have to live in gloom or despair! V1
- B. Because of Jesus we no longer have to live in darkness! V2
- C. Because of Jesus we can have a hope to be set free from the burdens of oppression! V4-5
- D. Because of Jesus we have a mighty counselor that we can go to so that He may become our prince of peace! V6
- E. Because of Jesus' justice and righteousness, we never have to go back to despair for His kingdom will reign forever! V7
