DIVING INTO SCRIPTURE

- John 7 ³⁷ Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, "<u>Anyone</u> who is thirsty may come to me! ³⁸ <u>Anyone</u> who believes in me may come and drink! For the Scriptures declare, '<u>Rivers of living water</u> will flow from his heart (his belly, his innermost being)." ³⁹ (When he said "living water," he was speaking of the <u>Spirit</u>, who would be <u>given to everyone believing in him.</u>) (NLT)
- Jn 14 ¹⁷ He is the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, who leads into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you know him, because he <u>lives with</u> you now and later will be <u>in you</u>. ¹⁸ No, I will <u>not abandon you as orphans</u>—I will come to you. ¹⁹ Soon the world will no longer see me, but you will see me. Since I live, you also will live. (NLT) ²³ "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and <u>make our home with them</u>. (NIV)
- Rom 5 5 He has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love. (NLT)
- Rom 8 ¹⁴ For those who are led by the <u>Spirit</u> of God are the <u>children</u> of God. ¹⁵ The <u>Spirit</u> you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the <u>Spirit</u> you received brought about your <u>adoption to sonship</u>. And by him we cry, <u>"Abba, Father."</u> ¹⁶ The <u>Spirit himself testifies with our spirit</u> that we are God's <u>children</u>. ¹७ Now if we are <u>children</u>, then we are <u>heirs—heirs</u> of God and <u>co-heirs</u> with Christ, if indeed we share in his <u>sufferings</u> in order that we may also share in his <u>glory</u>.
