# DON'T STEAL: I'VE STOLEN, NOW WHAT? - 2/13/22

### **GETTING OUR FEET WET-** I've stolen now what?

(Don't lie- PK reported 60% of taxes go to Social Programs with 80% going to Administration. Fact, 39% SS & Medicare, 26% Health, Welfare, 20% Defense & Vet, 6% debt, 3% Educ, 6% other, of which 1-13% goes to administration costs. SS is 35% of total tax, at 1% admin cost.)

# **DIVING INTO SCRIPTURE**

- Lev 6 2 "If anyone sins and is unfaithful to the LORD by deceiving a neighbor about something entrusted to them or left in their care or about something stolen, or if they cheat their neighbor, 3 or if they find lost property and lie about it, or if they swear falsely about any such sin that people may commit— 4 when they sin in any of these ways and realize their guilt, they must return what they have stolen or taken by extortion, or what was entrusted to them, or the lost property they found, 5 or whatever it was they swore falsely about. They must make restitution in full, add a fifth of the value to it and give it all to the owner on the day they present their guilt offering. 6 And as a penalty they must bring to the priest, that is, to the LORD, their guilt offering, a ram from the flock, one without defect and of the proper value. 7 In this way the priest will make atonement for them before the LORD, and they will be forgiven for any of the things they did that made them guilty."
- Luke 19 <sup>8</sup> But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half
  of my possessions to the poor, and if I have <u>cheated</u> anybody out of anything, I will <u>pay back</u>
  <u>four times the amount</u>." <sup>9</sup> Jesus said to him, "Today <u>salvation has come to this house</u>, because
  this man, too, is a <u>son of Abraham</u>. <sup>10</sup> For the Son of Man came to <u>seek and to save the lost</u>."
- Luke 23 <sup>39</sup> One of the criminals (thieves) who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Messiah? Save yourself and us!" <sup>40</sup> But the other criminal rebuked him. "Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? <sup>41</sup> We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong." <sup>42</sup> Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." <sup>43</sup> Jesus answered him, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise."

### TAKING IT HOME

Step 1- Stop stealing! - Eph 4:28

Step 2- Confess- to the Lord- Lev 6:7, Zacchaeus & the thief

- Deal with the heart- setting ourselves up as \_\_\_\_\_ leads to the breaking of all 10 Commands- Jas 4:11-12
- Step 3- Make restitution and add 20%- Lev 6, Num 5
- Step 4- Stand in your forgiveness- Lev 6, Zach & the thief
- Step 5- Go and do good- like Zach!

Buy-sell	Don't cheat, gouge, inflate	But charge fair prices, golden rule- treat others well- Mt 7

Poor	Don't be stingy, hard hearted, proud, judgmental	But be generous, helpful, help out of debt & get them on their feet, seek justice, fair laws- Dt 15
