PAROUSIA THE SECOND COMING OR SECOND ADVENT OF CHRIST.

Definition and Significance in the New Testament

The Greek word parousia ($\pi\alpha\rho\sigma\sigma(\alpha)$, parousia) means "presence" or "arrival." It is used as a technical term to refer to the return of Christ in glory at the end of this world. However, "parousia" is only one of a range of words used by the New Testament writers to refer to this event (Matt 24:3, 27, 37, 39; 1 Cor 15:23; 1 Thess 2:19; 3:13; 4:15; 5:23; 2 Thess 2:1, 8; Jas 5:7–8; 2 Pet 3:4, 12).

The Second Coming, also known as the Second Advent, is a term used in Christian theology to refer to the anticipated return of Jesus Christ to judge the living and the dead, and to establish God's kingdom in its fullness. It is believed to be a future event that will mark the culmination of human history and the fulfillment of God's plan of salvation. Also: Advent; The coming of Christ; Coming of Christ

 As Christians we should long for the second coming of Christ.

- A. We are to wait patiently for Christ Return Romans 8:18-25
 - i. All of creation waits for the completion of Christ's return.
 - ii. He will make things right once and for all
- B. We are not home and we should long to go where Christ will take us! Philippians 3:20
- C. We are to look for and hope for His coming Titus 2:13
- D. We are to keep ourselves in God's love anxiously awaiting His return. Jude 1:21
- E. We are to eagerly wait for His coming as we use the gifts God has given us. 1 Corinthians 5:7

2. Jesus will return in the flesh:

- A. Jesus will return the same way that He left Acts 1:9-12
- B. He will return in the flesh. 2 John 1:7-11

- B. Jesus will Judge us from the great white throne judgment that we see in Revelation 20:11-15
- C. Jesus will restore and make all things right for those who are in Him. Revelation 21:1-7
 - a. Jesus will walk with us side by side just as in the original creation.
 - b. He will wipe away every tear from our eyes.
 - c. He will make all things new!
 - d. He will reward those who are victorious!
- D. He will set everything right with the breath of His words 2 Thessalonians 2:3-10
