# DIVING INTO SCRIPTURE – 3 people who just told their story

Mark 5<sup>15</sup> When they came to Jesus, they saw the man who had been possessed by the legion of demons, sitting there, dressed and in his right mind; and they were afraid. <sup>16</sup> Those who had seen it told the people what had happened to the demon-possessed man—and told about the pigs as well. <sup>17</sup> Then the people began to plead with Jesus to leave their region. <sup>18</sup> As Jesus was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon-possessed begged to go with him. <sup>19</sup> Jesus did not let him, but said, "Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you." <sup>20</sup> So the man went away and began to tell in the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him. And all the people were amazed.

John 4<sup>28</sup> Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, <sup>29</sup> "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?" <sup>39</sup> Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever did."

John 9<sup>24</sup> A second time they summoned the man who had been blind. "Give glory to God by telling the truth," they said. "We know this man is a sinner." <sup>25</sup> He replied, "Whether he is a sinner or not, I don't know. One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!"

### SHARING OUR STORY- 3 STEPS

- PART 1 MY LIFE BEFORE I MET JESUS- what were you like? What did you struggle with? If you grew up in church, what was your life like before you got serious about following Him?
- PART 2- HOW I MET JESUS? How did you become a Christ follower? A crisis? A friend?
- PART 3 MY LIFE SINCE I MET JESUS- How has following Jesus changed you? Helped you in the good and hard times? How do you still fail or struggle? How are you still growing?

# TURNING 6 STUMBLING BLOCKS INTO 6 STEPPING STONES

- 1. I DON'T KNOW WHAT TO SAY
  - Share your story
  - Simple verses John 3:16- "For God so loved the world..., Rom 6:23- "The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord."
  - Simple stories- Thief on the cross, Lk 23:39-43, Sinful woman anointing Jesus Lk 7:36-50
  - Simple Tools- 3 Circles, The Invitation (CD), Evangecube, 4 Spiritual Laws, Website, Right Now Media, (careful on the "Canned", use these as supplements, adapt, personalize)
  - Set up a time- "Sometime I'd like to talk to you about my own spiritual journey."
  - Invite to church, special event, small group- "Come & see" Jn 2:46

#### 2. WHAT IF THEY ASK ME A HARD QUESTION?

- "That's a good question. Let me get back to you." Or- "What do you think?"
- Ask the Holy Spirit to help you- Mt 10:19-20
- People usually care more about your h and love than your logic.

# 3. I DON'T WANT TO IMPOSE MY BELIEFS ON MY FRIENDS AND FAMILY

- It's not our job to save anybody just to tell the t\_\_\_\_\_. Ezek 33
- If you don't tell them who will? "How can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?" (Rom 10:14, NLT)
- · Your own story is compelling but NOT imposing.
- "Sharing Jesus is one beggar telling another where he found bread"
- 79% of the unchurched are open to hear your story- if you first listen, don't pass judgment and share with genuine love and confidence.

#### 4. SHARING MY STORY MAKES ME FEEL UNCOMFORTABLE

- Sure, it does! Was it comfortable the first time you tried to ride a bike? Drive a car?
- The only way to get comfortable is to do the uncomfortable
- Write it out- 2-4 minutes
- Practice- by yourself, in front of a mirror, with a friend, a small Christian group...
- Ask God to give you some no-b\_\_\_\_\_ opportunities

## 5. BUT I FEEL SO ALONE

- Use the power of p\_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 2)
  - o Jesus promised to be with you and give you the Holy Spirit
  - O You are joining the conversation Jesus has already started
  - o Pray and keep praying to feel His presence as you share
- Use the power of fellow C\_\_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 2)
  - o It takes an average of 5 Christian friends and 2.5 years to lead someone to Christ
  - o If the person goes to church or joins a Christian group, it takes usually \_\_\_\_ weeks.
- Use the power of BLESS- don't let your story stand alone-(Acts 2)
  - o Shore up your story with the rest of the BLESS- pray, listen, eat, serve.

# 6. BUT I AM NOT GIFTED- I'm not an evangelist or pastor

- 70-90% come to faith in Jesus through \_\_\_\_\_\_\_
- Change your paradigm on evangelism- satisfied customers, "One beggar telling another where to find bread."
- Look at how Jesus himself did evangelism
