## FOLLOWING JESUS – LEARNING FROM JACOB

- 1. I\_\_\_\_\_ your idols
  - What do you overvalue?
  - What spiritual issues did your parents or grandparents struggle with?
  - Modern day idols- circle the idols you struggle with
  - Power- time, money, possessions, career, education
  - Pleasure- entertainment, hobbies, sports, sex, addictions, beauty
  - Relationships- family, people's opinion, appearance, love, co-dependency, enabling
- 2. B\_\_\_\_\_your idols have a <u>ceremony</u>- reaffirm God's love, power & control
  - Abraham took Isaac to the altar, Jacob buried them, Moses ground the calf...
- 3. WORSHIP the Lord & OBEY Him
  - ✓ Obey God in the very areas you've given your idols control
  - Time & Pleasure- devotions, Sabbath, serve- 1 hour a week
  - Money- tithe, give, share, set a maximum –give the rest
  - People's opinion- speak the truth in love, witness, be silent about your deeds
- 4. WATCH Him protect you
- ✓ <u>Hear</u> God's voice- What's God saying to you?
- ✓ <u>Obey</u>- Write or say it back in a prayer & obey-
- ✓ <u>Share</u>- Who do you need to share with, train, or serve?

## <u>NO IDOLS – Ex 20:4-6, 4/18/21</u>

- GETTING OUR FEET WET- idol making in real life
- DIVING INTO SCRIPTURE
- Ex 12<sup>12</sup> "On that same night I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn of both people and animals, and I will bring judgment on <u>all the gods of Egypt. I am the LORD</u>.
- Ex 19<sup>4</sup> 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. <sup>5</sup> Now <u>if you obey</u> me fully and <u>keep my covenant</u>, <u>then</u> out of all nations you will be my <u>treasured possession</u>. Although the whole earth is mine, <sup>6</sup> you will be for me a <u>kingdom of priests</u> and a <u>holy nation</u>.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites."
- Ex 19<sup>18</sup> Mount Sinai was covered with <u>smoke</u>, because <u>the LORD</u> descended on it in fire. The <u>smoke</u> billowed up from it like <u>smoke</u> from a furnace, and the whole <u>mountain trembled violently</u>. <sup>19</sup> As the sound of the <u>trumpet grew louder</u> and <u>louder</u>, Moses spoke and the voice of God answered him.
- Ex 20<sup>1</sup> And God spoke all these words, saying: <sup>2</sup> "I am the <u>LORD your God</u>, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. <sup>3</sup> "You shall have no other gods before me. <sup>4</sup> "You shall not make for yourself an <u>image</u> in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. <sup>5</sup> You shall not <u>bow down</u> to them or <u>serve</u> them; for I, <u>the LORD your God</u>, am a <u>jealous</u> God, <u>visiting</u> the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, <sup>6</sup> but <u>showing love</u> to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.
- I Sam 15<sup>22</sup> But Samuel replied: "Does <u>the LORD</u> delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying <u>the LORD</u>? <u>To obey is better than sacrifice</u>, and to heed is better than the fat of rams. <sup>23</sup> For rebellion is like the sin of <u>divination</u>, and arrogance like the evil of <u>idolatry</u>. Because you have rejected the word of <u>the LORD</u>, he has rejected you as king."
- Ezk 14<sup>3</sup> "Son of man, these men have <u>set up idols in their hearts</u> and put wicked stumbling blocks before their faces. Should I let them inquire of me at all?
- Col 3<sup>5</sup> Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is <u>idolatry</u>.
- I Jn 5<sup>21</sup> Dear children, keep yourselves from idols.

  - ✓ <u>Literally</u>- an image r\_\_\_\_\_ a deity
  - ✓ <u>Bible</u>'s 17 words for idol
  - ✓ <u>Spiritually</u>- an idol is something or someone we...

  - A\_\_\_\_\_ God-like qualities
  - Motive- idolatry is about c\_\_\_\_\_- to protect, guide, fulfill... (love, security, significance)
  - ✓ Therefore, IDOLATRY is
  - The over valuing of something or someone
  - The worship of the wrong gods
  - OR the worship of the right God w\_\_\_\_\_ (Saul- I Sam 15, Ezk 14, Mt 15:8, 20:20, Jas 4)

- ✓ Make
- ✓ Bow down
- ✓ S\_\_\_\_\_ (worship- Ex 1:13-14, 3:12, 20:2)
- > 1 MOTIVE- for y\_\_\_\_\_
- MADE FROM 3 SPHERES
- ✓ Heaven above
- ✓ Earth beneath
- ✓ Waters below

- > 2 REASONS TO OBEY
- ✓ WHO God is
  - For I the LORD
  - Your God
  - Am a j\_\_\_\_\_ (zealous) God (6x- only of God- Dt 4:24- exclusive devotion, bright red, guards his people, punishes spiritual adultery)
- ✓ WHAT God does
  - <u>Visiting</u> (punishing?) the children for the sins of their fathers to the <u>3<sup>rd</sup> &</u> <u>4<sup>th</sup></u> generation of those who <u>hate me</u> (visit, take note, oversee- for blessing or punishment- Gen 21:1, Ex 3:16, Lev 26:16)
  - But <u>showing steadfast love & mercy</u> (hesed, grace) to a <u>1,000</u> generations of those who <u>love me</u> and <u>keep my commandments</u>. (love- affection, Gen 22:2)
- ✤ FOLLOWING JESUS THE HOW TO
  - ✓ Learn a lesson from Jacob

Gen 35<sup>1</sup> Then God said to Jacob, "Go up to Bethel and settle there, and <u>build an</u> <u>altar there to God</u>, who appeared to you when you were fleeing from your brother Esau." <sup>2</sup> So Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, "<u>Get rid</u> of the <u>foreign gods</u> you have with you, and <u>purify your</u>selves and change your clothes. <sup>3</sup> Then come, let us go up to Bethel, where I will build an <u>altar to God</u>, who <u>answered me</u> in the day of my distress and who has <u>been with me</u> wherever I have gone." <sup>4</sup> So they gave Jacob all the <u>foreign gods</u> they had and the <u>rings in their</u> <u>ears</u>, and Jacob <u>buried them</u> under the oak at Shechem. <sup>5</sup> Then they set out, and the <u>terror of God fell on the towns</u> all around them so that no one pursued them.
