## SO. WHY SHOULD I READ THE BIBLE? - Josh 1:7-10, 6/4/23


### **GETTING OUR FEET WET**

**Joshua 1**<sup>7</sup> "Be <u>strong and very courageous</u>. Be <u>careful to obey</u> all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be <u>successful</u> wherever you go. <sup>8</sup> Keep this Book of the Law always on your <u>lips; meditate</u> on it day and night, so that you may be <u>careful to do</u> everything written in it. Then you will be <u>prosperous</u> and <u>successful</u>. <sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? Be <u>strong and courageous</u>. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God <u>will be with you</u> wherever you go."

This is God's Word. It is God's authority over me. It's God telling me who I am and what I'm to do. I will read it, obey it and share it, to be close to Jesus and bring others to Jesus.

#### SO, WHY SHOULD I READ THE BIBLE? - GOD'S 5 WHYS! F.L.O.W.S. (& there's more- Ps 119)

1. God's g\_\_\_\_\_\_- splendor, majesty, beauty, praise, power, joy, delight...

- Job 38<sup>4</sup> "Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation? <sup>7</sup> while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy?
- 1 Chr 16:24 Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!
- Prov 8<sup>22</sup> "The LORD brought me (Wisdom) forth as the first of his works, before his deeds of old; <sup>29</sup> when he gave the sea its boundary so the waters would not overstep his command, and when he marked out the foundations of the earth. <sup>30</sup> Then I was constantly at his side. I was filled with delight day after day, rejoicing always in his presence,<sup>31</sup> rejoicing in his whole world and delighting in mankind.
- Rom 11<sup>36</sup> For from him and through him and for him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen.
- 1 Cor 10:31 So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
- 2. Jesus
  - John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.(see Heb 1:3)
  - Jn 5<sup>39</sup> You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that testify about me
  - Lk 24<sup>25</sup> He said to them, "How foolish you are, and how slow to believe all that the prophets have spoken! <sup>26</sup> Did not the Messiah have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?" <sup>27</sup> And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.
  - Is it only about Jesus??
    - 1 Cor 10<sup>5</sup> Nevertheless, God was not pleased with most of them; their bodies were scattered in the wilderness.<sup>6</sup> Now these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did. (see also Rom 15:4, Heb 11, Jas 5:11,17-18)

- 3. F trusting
  - Gen 15<sup>6</sup> Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness.
  - Jn 3<sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
  - Rom 10<sup>17</sup> So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- 4. L
  - Mt 22 <sup>37</sup> Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' <sup>40</sup> All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."
- 5. O
  - Jn 14<sup>23</sup> Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. <sup>24</sup> Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me.
  - Jas 1<sup>22</sup> Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.
- 6. S
  - Dt 6<sup>4</sup>Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. <sup>5</sup>Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. <sup>6</sup> These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. <sup>7</sup> Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. 9 Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.
  - Mt 10<sup>27</sup> What I tell you in the dark, speak in the daylight; what is whispered in your ear, proclaim from the roofs. <sup>28</sup> Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.
  - Mt 28<sup>18</sup> Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
