We don't worship the Bible; we worship the one it reveals. I think it's silly to have to defend God's book. No amount of proof will change minds if hearts are hard. It's like God knew this conflict would happen, and He wrote His book to handle it; He gave us all we need. So, the debate and argument over changing the Bible is not with us, but with God; He wins all debates, eventually.
