 - Ex 23¹² "Six days do your work, but on the seventh day do not work, so that your <u>ox and</u> <u>your donkey</u> may rest, and so that the slave born in your household and the foreigner living among you may be refreshed.
 - Lev 25³ For six years sow your fields, and for six years prune your vineyards and gather their crops. ⁴ But in the seventh year the land is to have a year of sabbath rest, a sabbath to the LORD. Do not sow your fields or prune your vineyards. ⁶ Whatever the land yields during the sabbath year will be food for you—, ⁷ as well as for your <u>livestock</u> and the <u>wild</u> <u>animals</u> in your land.
