- In the OT- 7 days of creation, 7 festivals, 7 weeks till Pentecost, 7th year of rest, Jubilee after 7 periods of 7 years, 7 priests, with 7 trumpets marched around Jericho 7 times, Joshua marched around Jericho 7 times, Naaman washed 7 times, Daniel's 70 weeks
- In the NT- Jesus feeds 4,000 with 7 loaves, 7 churches, 7 lampstands, 7 angels, seven stars,
 7-fold Spirit, 7 eyes, 7 horns, 7 years, 7 seals, 7 trumpets, 7 bowls
- In Jesus' genealogy- try writing a genealogy and meet these criteria- all must be divisible by 7
- 1. The number of words, letters, vowels, and consonants
