GOD'S VALUE OF HUMAN LIFE

Gen 4¹⁰ The LORD said, "What have you done? Listen! Your <u>brother's blood</u> cries out to me from the ground.

Gen 9⁵ And for <u>your lifeblood</u> I will surely demand an accounting. I will demand an accounting from every animal. And from each human being, too, I will demand an accounting for the life of another human being. ⁶ "Whoever sheds <u>human blood</u>, by humans shall <u>their blood</u> be shed; for in the image of God has God made mankind.

Gen 42²² Reuben replied, "Didn't I tell you not to sin against the boy? But you wouldn't listen! Now we must give an accounting for <u>his blood</u>."

Ex 22² "If a thief is caught breaking in at night and is struck a fatal blow, the defender is not guilty of <u>bloodshed</u>; ³ but if it happens after sunrise, the defender is guilty of <u>bloodshed</u>.

Dt 22 ⁸ When you build a new house, make a parapet around your roof so that you may not bring the guilt of <u>bloodshed</u> on your house if someone falls from the roof.

Ps 5 ⁶ The <u>bloodthirsty</u> and deceitful you, LORD, detest. 9 ¹² For he who avenges <u>blood</u> remembers; he does not ignore the cries of the afflicted. 72 ¹⁴ He will rescue them from oppression and violence, for precious is their <u>blood</u> in his sight.

Jer 22³ This is what the LORD says: Do what is just and right. Rescue from the hand of the oppressor the one who has been robbed. Do no wrong or violence to the foreigner, the fatherless or the widow, and do not shed <u>innocent blood</u> in this place.

Ps 51 ¹⁴ Deliver me from the guilt of <u>bloodshed</u>, O God, you who are God my Savior, and my tongue will sing of your righteousness.

Mt 26 ²⁸ This is my <u>blood</u> of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

✤ WHAT DID GOD SAY ORIGINALLY- THE HEBREW?

- A. KILL- 172x- "HAW-RAG" (Strong's 2026)- NOT the 10 Commandment word
- 1. Definition- to strike with deadly intent
- 2. Bible's Usage- general human, animal (2x), plant (1x), moral or immoral, legal or illegal
 - 121x-kill (in the NASB)
 - 46x- slay, slaughter, slain
 - 4x murder
 - 1x each- destroy, smite
- 3. A synonym with "murder" but not always equal with murder
 - Gen 4 ⁸ Cain attacked his brother Abel and <u>killed</u> him.
 - Gen 4²³ Lamech said, "I killed a man for wounding me, a young man for injuring me."
 - Ex 21 ¹² "Anyone who strikes a person with a fatal blow is to be put to death. ¹³ However, if it is not done intentionally, but God lets it happen, they are to flee to a place I will designate. ¹⁴ But if anyone schemes and <u>kills</u> someone deliberately, that person is to be taken from my altar and put to death.
 - Lev 24²¹ Whoever <u>kills</u> an animal must make restitution, but whoever <u>kills</u> a human being is to be put to death.
 - Ps 94⁶ They kill the widow and the foreigner; they murder the orphan.
- 4. Conclusion- use the 3 keys to determine meaning
 - Key 1- Context- can range from moral killing to immoral murder
 - Key 2- Motive- kill becomes murder with intentional, deliberate, scheming
