"Webster's definition of a disciple is "a pupil or follower of any teacher or school."[i] A true disciple is not just a student or a learner, but a follower: one who applies what he has learned. Thus, a true disciple will ask, "What would "Jesus do?""

1. A disciple is someone who answers the call of Christ! John 3:3, Matthew 4:18-22

19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent. 20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.-- Revelation 3:19-20

- A. Jesus' call is extended to all, but only His disciples answer it!
- B.) Christ calls His disciples to a new life! They are to leave the old one behind!
- C.) We are called to follow Him!
- 2. A disciple is someone who answers the call to come and die! (Luke 9:23-27, Colossians 2:6-15, Romans 12:2, Matthew 19:16-22)
 - A. A disciple is someone who denies themselves, and dies daily to their flesh!

- B.) They walk in step and are filled with the Spirit!
